We are pleased that you are interested in participating in the Upward Bound Math Science Program (UBMS) at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette. UBMS is designed to prepare high school students for post-secondary education programs that lead to STEM careers (or careers in math, science, engineering, technology, or teaching careers in these areas). Before filling out this application, we ask that you and your parents take your time reading the information so that you understand the benefits of participating and your long-term commitment to the program.

UL Lafayette's UBMS program serves 63 high school students from five area high schools. Students will take part in engaging enrichment courses and activities throughout the academic year (monthly meetings and assignments & some Saturday sessions) and during the summer (six-week summer enrichment program). Program activities are designed to meet the individual needs of students to: a) strengthen their skills in reading, math, writing, and scientific reasoning skills, b) assist them in attaining ACT scores for TOPS and entrance into post-secondary education, c) work with research mentors to prepare for rigorous math/science research and coursework in college, and/or d) possibly earn college credit before graduating from high school (through Dual Enrollment or UL Lafayette's University College opportunities. Please note that you will receive more details after completing the initial paperwork.

Completion of this application packet will establish eligibility, but it does not guarantee that you will be accepted into the program. Participants who meet the eligibility requirements will receive additional forms to complete and a follow-up interview. All students initially enter a probationary period in which UBMS staff may monitor students' academic work, and applicants may decide if they can meet program goals and requirements. APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. In ink, <u>complete all forms and hand written</u> <u>essay</u> <u>responses</u>. Return them by the designated deadline. (*Late or incomplete applications may not be considered.*)
- 2. Request and collect a <u>recommendation from</u> one high school <u>math AND</u> one high school <u>science teacher</u>.
- 3. Submit your parent(s)' or guardian's <u>latest</u> tax return, or any other proof of income, e.g. social security, SSI benefits, food stamps, etc.
- 4. If you meet all eligibility requirements, you will be sent a second set of forms to complete and asked for an interview with the UBMS staff after making the initial selection cut. Participants will be notified of their selection status usually within 40 days of

receipt of a completed application.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, each participant must:

<u>Level 1:</u> Come from families that are considered by the federal government guidelines to be low income and/or first generation.

- **a. Low income** status is determined from the line for <u>taxable income</u> on the 1040 Federal Income Tax form (or equivalent line on other forms) AND by the number of people currently in the household. If the parent(s) has not filed, other documentation, such as benefits should be included.
- **b. First generation** means that neither of the participant's parents has <u>completed</u> a bachelor's degree. If the participant lives in a single-parent household and that parent has not completed a bachelor's degree, then the participant is classified as first generation.

Note: The UBMS staff will screen for eligibility.

<u>Level 2</u>: Have good grades in science and math and an overall 2.5 GPA or higher

<u>Level 3</u>: Plan to attend college AND major in a math and/or science based program;

Level 4: Be currently enrolled in the 9th, 10th, or 11th grade and be willing to develop oneself through out the school year and each summer through participation until he/she completes high school. (Sorry recruitment of Seniors is not allowed.)
